### [NEW USER OVERVIEW](#)

To request secure user access, new users should:

1. Visit the [Find Colleges & Universities](#) page to locate their institutional profile page.
2. Click the name of your institution and scroll to the bottom of the institutional profile page to view the institution's current list of MTN Secure Users.
3. Email this group to identify which person is authorized to grant secure user access and request that they add you with a minimum access level to "Run Reports" and any other appropriate access levels for your role on campus.
4. Click the next heading in this listing for *Michigan Transfer Network (MTN)* to review resources designed to acclimate new secure users to the back-end of the site.
